This year, 620 Dance Centre will produce our Spring Demonstration for our students on May 8, 2010 at The Waldorf School Performing Arts Center, located at 8700 South View Road, Austin, TX 78737. It is rewarding for the dancers to display their talents and share their enthusiasm with the audience on such an exciting occasion. Participating in the Concert is a privilege and should be taken seriously regardless of the level or age of the student.

It is important for you to fully understand the Spring Demonstration Agreement. By giving you this important information in advance, we can be sure that everyone knows the policies and procedures before committing to participate in our Demonstration. We want nothing more than to provide the best for our students and this includes having a wonderful year-end Demonstration! Having everyone who is involved cooperate, will aid us in providing the best performance experience for every dancer.

SPRING DEMONSTRATION DATE IS SATURDAY, MAY 8, 2010

Upon signing the Spring Demonstration Agreement, you are agreeing that your dancer will be in the Spring Demonstration. Nothing is more devastating to a class than to have a student drop out once staging has been set. Please impress upon your dancer that it is very important to follow through with the year.

ATTENDANCE & COMMITMENT

620 Dance Centre reserves the right to remove students who are not attending class on a regular basis from the Demonstration. Dancers who miss multiple classes create a disruptive learning experience for the entire class. Springtime brings a multitude of activities that peak our interests, however they are not valid excuses to miss class. Though we do not strive for "perfection", students do need to learn the choreography and teachers need to be able to set staging. Every child's participation in the Demonstration is crucial. It is inconsiderate to inform the teacher that a child will be unable to perform in the Demonstration once the choreography has been started. Please check your schedule for May 7th and 8th, 2010 before signing this agreement.

PERFORMANCE FEES

A Performance Fee of \$40.00 per student or \$60.00 per family is due by November 1, 2009, in order for students to perform in the Demonstration. Late fees will apply. The fee is used to cover the expenses we incur holding the Demonstration including rental fees, technical fees and numerous other items.

COSTUMES

In an effort to help each family hold down expenses, there will be NO required purchase of dancewear for this year's Demonstration. Each student will be required to wear a solid black leotard and either black jazz pants, or black booty shorts w/tights, whichever is specified by their teacher. Everyday dancewear that meets the studio dress code will be acceptable. For some classes, there may be a minimal charge for a skirt or accessory piece.

REHEARSAL & DEMONSTRATION POLICIES

DRESS REHEARSAL WILL BE THE AFTERNOON AND/OR EVENING OF FRIDAY, MAY 7TH, 2010 AND/OR THE MORNING OF SATURDAY, MAY 8TH, 2010.

Dress rehearsals are mandatory for dancers participating in the Demonstration. If your dancer is participating in the Demonstration they must attend the dress rehearsal, in the required dancewear, to be ready to perform. There are NO exceptions to this rule. Rehearsal schedules will be distributed after the first of the year.

During the Demonstration, dancers will sit together backstage, as a class, the entire act in which they perform. No dancer will be released prior to the intermission and/or end of the Demonstration. The backstage area is well-secured and only staff, dancers and assigned stage mothers (two per class) are allowed in this area. Each class under the age of 10 will be required to have two stage mothers in order for the class to perform. So that you are able to concentrate fully on your dancer, it is recommended that you DO NOT bring younger siblings and/or larger strollers to the backstage area, space is limited, and we are not equipped to have more children than those participating in the area.

STAGE MAKE UP

Make up is mandatory; students dancing in the Demonstration will be expected to wear a certain amount of makeup during the performance. This is needed due to the lighting we have on our stage. You will be given specific information on this, along with hair instructions, in the spring.

TICKETS

Each student will receive 4 tickets to the Demonstration. Families with more than one student enrolled will receive 6 tickets. Seating capacity of this facility is 400 maximum. After tickets have been distributed to our families, any extra tickets may be purchased for \$10 each.

AUDIENCE ETIQUETTE

NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEO OF ANY KIND DURING THE DEMONSTRATION. This is dangerous and distracting for the performers and inconsiderate to the other audience members. Should a guest choose not to follow this rule, that audience member will be asked to leave. A professional photographer and videographer will be provided, by the studio, for class portraits and Demonstration video.

We ask that you treat the Demonstration as a professional performance. Please remain seated for the entire performance. It is not proper to leave the theatre unless it is an emergency during a performance of this type. It is disrespectful to the dancers and the people around you. If you must leave your seat, please do so between dances or at intermission.

It is at the discretion of the Director of 620 Dance Centre and/or The Waldorf School Performing Arts Center to remove any audience member, parent or dancer who is disrespectful to any volunteer or staff member working the Demonstration.

Rehearsal and Demonstration dates are handed out well in advance. This enables everyone to make arrangements regarding time off from work, family vacations and other activities to ensure that the dancer will be in attendance.
